FAFSA COMPLETION EVENTS

Guidelines for Participating Organizations

1. Purpose

i. The Georgia FAFSA Completion Initiative, is sponsored by the Georgia Student Finance Commission (GSFC). It consists of FREE events where selected schools and volunteers help students and families who need assistance in completing their FAFSA, with a particular focus on helping low-income, first-generation families. The federal government requires a FAFSA from all students seeking financial aid to pay for college, such as Pell Grants and federal student loans.

2. Supporting the Program

- i. The success of the program depends in part on support from the communities in which it takes place. This support is from non-profit entities, businesses and individuals who support the educational and charitable mission of the program. Supporters are invited, and encouraged to contribute, subject to the following:
- ii. The name and identity of the Georgia FAFSA Completion Initiative must be protected. A funder may not be the exclusive, or sole, supporter of the Georgia FAFSA Completion Initiative nor may a supporter state or imply ownership or control of the Georgia FAFSA Completion Initiative name or program.
- iii. Supporters of the Georgia FAFSA Completion Initiative will be recognized as being a contributor to the program through listings in promotional materials if applicable.
- iv. Support of the Georgia FAFSA Completion Initiative activities is not intended to represent a business development or marketing opportunity, nor may support of the Georgia FAFSA Completion Initiative be used to further a political agenda, candidate, position or platform.
- v. Georgia FAFSA Completion Initiative supporters are expected to have missions that are consistent with and in furtherance of that of the FAFSA Completion Initiative, and operate in a fashion that is consistent with prevailing community standards.
- vi. Support for the Georgia FAFSA Completion Initiative is deductible as a charitable contribution to the extent provided by law.
