By gaining a greater understanding of federal and state financial aid, as well as the college search and application process, students can overcome the common misconceptions about college degrees being inaccessible; and
- WHEREAS:** Studies show that college graduates enjoy higher incomes, better health, and greater levels of community involvement; and
- WHEREAS:** The State of Georgia and its education agencies work in partnership to better prepare the state's next generation of leaders for the opportunities and challenges of the 21st century; and
- WHEREAS:** Increasing the number of Georgia citizens pursuing a college degree, including minorities, students from rural areas, and first-generation students can help to create generational change; and
- WHEREAS:** Georgia Apply to College Month provides an important opportunity to increase awareness of higher education opportunities among high school seniors and to provide a supportive atmosphere for all students applying to college; now
- THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim November 2020 as APPLY TO COLLEGE MONTH Georgia.
