The application process for the Georgia Peace Officer’s Loan Repayment Program requires applicants to submit verified employment by an eligible law enforcement office, agency, or department in Georgia to the Georgia Student Finance Authority (GSFA). The Employer Verification Form must be completed by the applicant and the employer(s).

Note: Group 1 - Newly employed Peace Officer with a Bachelor’s Degree, eligible employment start date must begin on or after January 1, 2024. **Group 2** - Peace Officer enrolled in a Bachelor’s Degree in a field of Criminal Justice provide your employment start date. Eligible employment requires working 12 consecutive months full time or part time (in two or more positions equaling full time) and have Peace Officers Standard of Training (POST) certification, including the power to arrest in Georgia.
