

# Inclusive Postsecondary Education (IPSE) Grant Program

The Inclusive Postsecondary Education (IPSE) Grant Program assists students with qualifying intellectual and developmental disabilities, and enrolled in an approved IPSE program, at an approved University System of Georgia (USG) or Technical College System of Georgia (TCSG) Eligible Institution. The grant award can assist with standard undergraduate tuition, mandatory fees or program fees.

The IPSE award amount is based on tuition, mandatory fees and program fees. A student may be awarded a maximum of 15 credit hours per term. The IPSE award can be applied towards a student’s tuition, mandatory student fees, and/or program fees. Please review the IPSE award amounts on **GAfutures.org** to determine your award amount.

Students have two ways which they can apply for the Inclusive Postsecondary Education Grant:

- 1. Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or,
- 2. Complete the online Georgia Student Finance Application (GSFAPP)

*Note: The FAFSA must be completed each year. The GSFAPP remains valid for 10 years.*

### Application Deadline

A student must file a GSFAPP or FAFSA on or before the last day of the school term or the student’s withdrawal date whichever occurs first to receive payment for a term.

*Note: The end of the school term may be the final day of classes or exams, whichever occurs later.*
